



Public Works Utilities Systems Technician

(Salary Grade 12: \$35,788 – \$55,472 Annually)

The Town of Benson has an immediate opening for a Utilities Systems Technician in its Public Works Department. The anticipated hiring range is \$35,788 - \$42,349. Benefits include paid participation in the North Carolina State Health Plan, paid dental, vision and life insurance, 5% 401(K) match, 12 paid holidays and two weeks paid time-off per year, and an abundant wellness program that includes incentives.

As a Utilities Systems Technician, you will assist the Utilities Systems Manager in maintaining critical utilities infrastructure associated with the town's water, collections and stormwater systems. Your primary responsibility as a Utilities System Technician will be to ensure that all system components are continually functioning efficiently and effectively.

Some of the duties of the Utilities Systems Technician include:

- * Assisting with compliance of water, collections and stormwater MS4 permit requirements
- * Inspecting pumps, motors, controllers, water meters, main lines, service lines and SCADA system for proper installation and operation
- * Recording and analyzing daily water usage at the town's bulk water entry points
- * Taking potable water samples and submitting bacteriological samples to the lab
- * Monitoring water distribution system disinfectant residuals
- * Completing maintenance tasks such as valve exercising, pressure switch maintenance, replacing defective pressure gauges, auto flusher maintenance and tank inspections
- * Completing routine water distribution system flushing
- * Troubleshooting water quality complaints
- * Assisting with customer compliance of the town's F.O.G. (Fats, Oils and Grease) Program
- * Inspecting manholes and high priority collection system main lines
- * Assisting with completion of utility locate requests

Requirements:

Must possess a valid North Carolina Driver's License

May be requested to attend paid water and collections operators' certification school after training
