The Town of Benson Fire Department is now accepting qualified applications and personal resumes for the position of **Fire Engineer**. This will be a 48-96 rotating **ABC** shift position. The annual starting salary is \$55,077, before scheduled overtime and 13 paid holidays. Benefits include paid participation in the North Carolina State Health Plan, paid dental, paid vision, life insurance, 5% 401(K) contributions, and an abundant wellness program that includes incentives.

Candidate performs varied tasks vital to the overall fire suppression and emergency response efforts of a municipal fire department. Candidate will respond to emergency calls and function as a Fire Engineer and an Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) and must be experience in fire ground operations, equipment/apparatus operations, emergency medical care, and hazardous materials. Candidate will assist with station duties, public fire education, equipment maintenance, vehicle maintenance, hydrant maintenance, preplans, hose testing, and contribute to the overall emergency response readiness of the department. Applicants must pass a medical and physical examination with a drug test as required in N.F.P.A 1001.

- Minimum of 2 Years' Experience as a Driver Operator and Must Provide Documentation

Preferred for candidate to have North Carolina Fire Prevention Level 1 but not required.

Testing Requirements:

You will be notified if you are invited to participate in our testing process.

- Must Pass Written Test
- Must Pass a Pumping Test
- Interview
